

HERE WAS a change in my life as complete as it had been sudden. In the twinkling of an eye I was transformed from a sailor into a "beach-comber" and a hide-out let the novelty and the complete independence of my life were not to be denied. Our hide-out house was a large building made of rough-hewn logs and intended to hold forty thousand hides for one year. It was divided into small rooms, each of which had its own stove, and we were to live with nothing but our own tools, our own pots, spoons, plates, etc. and our own fire for fuel in the light. Here we put our things, threw our bedding into the berths, and took up our quarters. Over our heads was another small room, in which Mr. Russell lived, who had charge of the hide-house, the same man who was for a time an officer of the *Pilgrim*. There he lived in solitary grandeur, eating and sleeping alone (and these were his principal occupations), and communing with his own dignity. The boy, a Marblehead hopeful, whose name was Sam, was to act as cook; while I, a giant of a Frenchman or a professional man, and had been in a merchant's counting-room in Boston, we found that we had some acquaintances and topics in common. We talked these matters over — Boston, what our friends were probably doing, our voyage, etc. — until he went to take his turn at the lookout, and left me to myself. I had now a good opportunity for reflection. I felt for the first time the perfect silence of the sea. The officer was walking the quarter-deck, where I had no right to go, one or two men were talking on the fore-castle, whom I had little inclination to join, so that I was left open to the full impression of everything about me. However much I was affected by the beauty of the sea, the bright stars, and the clouds driven swiftly over them, I could not but remember that I was separating myself from all the social and intellectual enjoyments of life. 

Parliament meeting more often. The common peoples representatives got into the habit of meeting privately to discuss their business before they joined the lords. By 1250 they also had a speaker whose duty was to communicate their agreed opinions to the lords. Over the next ten years Parliament divided into three parts: a House of Commons, a House of Lords and a small permanent council composed of the King's advisers.

Edward III was quite content to increase Parliaments powers as long as it supported his wars. As for the Commons, they considered wars to be the kings business, but they were happy to pay for them as they brought some profit to country; they were well aware of the importance of the ports of Calais and Bordeaux to English commerce. The common people's representatives who filled the commons were also involved with matters such as order and justice. In fact for some time these men had been used as unpaid servants of the crown to keep public order everywhere. Edward now appointed them Justices of the Peace and gave them the local powers of his sheriffs and judges.

Although Edward continued to make conquests in France he was unable to maintain them, as the Black Death struck again and before his fifty year reign had come to an end in 1377, the Black Plance and some of his best captains were dead. France was now again, except for Calais, Bordeaux and a few other ports.

The heir to the throne was Edward's grandson, Richard II. However, as Richard was only ten years old at the time of his grandfather's death, his uncle, John of Gaunt ruled in his name and became Steward of England. John of Gaunt tried hard to re-establish the authority of the Steward: the manager of the kingdom.



Reaching the brow of the hill, where the car stood, we found several piles of hides, and Indians sitting round them. One or two other carts were coming slowly on from the mission, and the captain told us to begin and throw the hides down. This, then, was the way they were to be got down—thrown down, one at a time, a distance of four hundred feet! This was doing the business on a great scale. Standing on the edge of the hill and looking down the perpendicular height, the sailors

Down this height we pitched the hides, throwing them as far out into the air as we could, and as they were all large, stiff, and doubled, like the cover of a book, the wind took them, and they swayed and eddied about, plunging and rising in the air, like a kite when it has broken its string. As it was now low tide, there was no danger of their falling into the water, and, as fast as they came to ground, the men below picked them up, and, taking them on their heads, walked off with them to the boat. It was really a picturesque sight, the great height, the scaling of the hides, and the continual walking to and fro of the men, who looked like mites, on the beach. This was the romance of hide-droghing!

Some of the hides lodged in cavities under the bank and out of our sight, being directly under us; but by pitching other hides in the same direction, we

flavour, for the confusion of everything below, and the inexpressibly sickening smell, the dark, dank skin top of bilge water in the hold, made the leakage and indifferent refuge from the cold wet decks. I had often read of the nautical experiences of others, but I felt as though there could be none worse than mine; for, in addition to every other evil, I could not but remember that it was only the first night of a two years' voyage. When we were on deck we were not much better off, for we were in a comfortable scene, about the officer, who said that it was good for us to be in motion. Yet anything was better than the horrible state of things below. I remember very well going to the hatchway and putting my head down, when I was oppressed by nausea, and always being relieved immediately.

This scene of things continued for two days.






Boston Bay Massachusetts Bay, smooth surface wind black cloud upon multiplying




